JS felt he should bring it to the attention of the PC although no planning application had been made at this stage. Obviously if an application was made it would go before a full PC meeting as normal. It was felt that this information should not be made public as the proposed site may cause upset to a number of residents and as nothing was definite yet it seemed appropriate not cause un-necessary worry to residents. JS said the landowner wished to have a meeting to discuss this. All agreed we should hear what the land owner had to suggest before making anything public.</p>
